

## 'Historic' Bennion Family Reunion Meets in Taylorsville

The biennial Bennion Family Reunion was held on Saturday, August 22, 1992, at the Taylorsville Stake Center, traditional site of the gathering of the clan. The day's activities followed the familiar format. There were displays of family records, artifacts, memorabilia and books, together with greetings of relatives and friends. Steve Bennion displayed a wide array of computer materials available for those interested. He also encouraged family members to submit current vital statistics on all families to keep the computer data base updated to include the latest Bennion born.

One of the outstanding displays of the day was the old sheep wagon built originally by Samuel R. Bennion in about 1868. It is being restored by Mike Shurtleff, a third great grandson of Samuel Bennion. It is on display as one of the permanent features at the "Pioneer Trails State Park" near the "This Is The Place" Monument in the mouth of Emigration Canyon. For details on the history and restoration of the wagon, see the story in the September 1991 issue of the Recorder.

Following the family luncheon in the picnic shelter, the traditional intra-family Tug-of-War was staged in the park, with "earth-shaking" results. After having dominated the competition for many years, as far back as memory goes, the John Bennion branch of the family was finally subdued by a more aggressive Samuel Bennion branch. With a super-human effort and probably a few more

Bennions on their side of the rope, *the 'Samuels' finally pulled the 'Johns' over the line for their first recorded win in the history of the contest!!*

The annual meeting featured a moving talk by Bennion Family patriarch, Bishop Lowell L. Bennion. Speaking of his philosophy of service to our fellowman, especially to the under-privileged and less fortunate, he spoke as one who really knows whereof he speaks, considering his lifetime of service and teaching.

# GENEALOGICA BUSHELLORUM!!

---

GENEALOGICA BUSHELLORUM is the scholarly title given to an unusual document which has come into the possession of the Bennion Family of Utah. It is of special interest to the "Bushell Branch" of the Bennion family because Samuel Bennion's wife was Mary Bushell, daughter of John Bushell and Martha Rowland, born in Roby Parish, Huyton, Lancashire, England, March 1, 1816. On April 28, 1839, Samuel and Mary were married in St. Nicholas Church in Liverpool and immigrated to Utah in 1845, arriving in the Salt Lake Valley with the early companies of Mormon Pioneers in October, 1847.

The document was researched and written by Thomas A. Bushell, A.M. Inst. T., of Chiselhurst, Kent, England. Unaware of being touched by the spirit of Elijah, Mr. Bushell spent many years in the late 1940s and '50s working at his hobby researching the genealogy of the Bushell Family throughout England, including Lancashire and Cheshire, the vicinity of origin of our Bushell family, as indicated in our own records.

In the first chapter Mr. Bushell tells of our progenitors coming across the English Channel with William of Normandy in A.D. 1066. The name appears on the famous Battle Abbey Roll and its four successor rolls, the original having been destroyed by fire. Sometimes it is listed as Bushell, at other times in variant spelling forms as Buscel, Busshell, or Boissel, apparently all of French origin. Further evidence is obtained from the Domesday Book, generally held to have been completed in A.D. 1086, where the name Bushell also appears. The family spread throughout many counties of England and, while we do not yet know how we are related to these families, the depth of Mr. Bushell's research offers us the assurance that we are. The work of identifying that connection remains as a major Family History research project yet to be accomplished.

In another chapter Mr. Bushell

discusses the "Etymology" of the Bushell name, its derivation and meaning. The chapter on "Heraldry" explains that since, "armorial bearings did not come into use until the XII century; the Bushells of William the Conqueror's day therefore had none." However, as the institution developed in the twelfth century, Mr. Bushell writes that, "The original arms granted to Sir Alan Bushell of Brodmerston (d. 1245) - - have been widely used [and] are attributed with slight variations to four different families of Bushells. - - They are found in Neston Church, Wirral, Cheshire, and on memorials to a well-known Liverpool family of Bushells". The Chester branch of the family is the most likely area where our connection may be made. The document contains, in addition to its interesting narrative, many pages of pedigree diagrams showing several generations of Bushells, even down to his own time in the 1950's.

But how we came by our distant cousin, Mr. Thomas A. Bushell of Kent and his work, is a story in itself. He relates that as he was doing his research, he came upon a note in a Churchwarden's record, - -, but let's have him tell the story in his own words:

"The Birchington records shew that a Thomas Bushell was rated as the holder of 27 acres of land there in 1680. - - In 1694 the rate was assessed on rent at 3d in the £ and Thomas Bushell (probably the son of the first Thomas Bushell) was called upon to pay one shilling and ninepence. He must have left Birchington in that year for we find the following entry in the Churchwarden's Book, 'Thomas Bushell went away and did not pay his sess. 00:01:09.' On finding this entry - - I thought it a desirable gesture to pay the amount and this I did in October, 1952 (only 258 years late - with no interest). - - Instead of cashing the postal order, the Churchwardens saw fit to have it framed and hung up in the vestry. Thus the matter soon became news.

The story appeared in the Sunday Express, Sunday Dispatch, Evening News, Isle of Thanet Gazette and Kentish Times, not to mention 'Punch'! I later heard of it in Paris and in far-away Seattle, Washington, U.S.A."

*Apparently the story was picked up by the international news wire services and also may have appeared in the Salt Lake City newspapers for, as Mr. Bushell continues:*

"Whilst these notes have been in preparation, the writer has received a letter from Mr. Hyrum Bennion, Junior, of Salt Lake City, Utah, U.S.A., he having become cognisant of this work by reference in a United States publication to the one shilling and ninepence paid by the writer to the Parish of Birchington in respect of a parish rate left unpaid by an ancestor in 1694. - - - Mr. Bennion is a grandson of Mary, daughter of John and Martha Bushell, born in Roby Parish, Huyton, Lancashire - - - This interesting information was received just in time for inclusion in this chapter on the Bushells of Liverpool."

Based on the news story, Hyrum Bennion, Jr. began a correspondence with Mr. Bushell of Kent, resulting in a series of letters, five of which we have, written between September 1955 and February 1957. Before Hyrum died in February 1956, he passed the letter file to his cousin, June Bennion Sharp, who continued the correspondence, of which we have one letter from Mr. Bushell, dated 7 June 1959. When the work was completed, Mr. Bushell sent a copy of the full document to June B. Sharp, sixty-nine pages, minus p.1, the title page. In the early 1960's the document was given to his son, Richard G. Sharp, [*our new Bennion Family President!*] with the hope that it would stimulate further research to tie the families together. For the past thirty years or so it has lain dormant, carefully filed away, regarded as something of

great value, but how, when or what to do with it has remained unknown until recently.

The recent development of the personal computer and its use in the Church's Family History program with the "Personal Ancestral File", has unlocked the first door. The more recent development of the "Temple Ready" computer program has unlocked another door by which approximate dates may be established and records prepared for ordinance work in the Temple. To date 179 names of Bushells and collateral family lines have been extracted and cleared and are in the "Family File" awaiting ordinance work in the Salt Lake Temple. Some of the work has been done but much more remains. There are probably two or three hundred more names to be extracted and prepared for "Temple Ready" computer processing. In addition, the research necessary to establish our connection with Mr. Bushell's family in England remains as a challenge. It is likely that many more family names and collateral lines may be discovered in that process. Bennion-Bushell family members and others who desire are invited to participate — just go to the Family File desk in the Salt Lake Temple and ask for the Richard Sharp file!

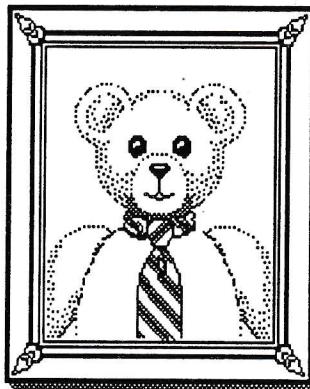

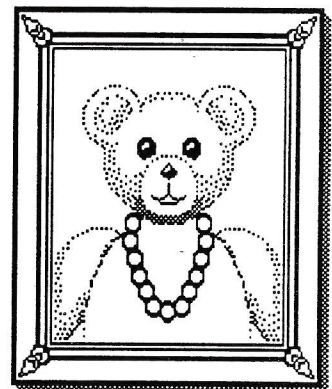

Rather than reprint entire pages for small additions, we have decided to just list the updates here. The page numbers refer to the April 1992 Bennion Family Recorder (volume 4, issue 1):

Page 17: Richard Street (father, born December 1636) was sealed to "Anna or Anne Street" again on 17 March 1991 in the Salt Lake Temple. Previous sealings undoubtedly have occurred, but the information was somehow lost in the records.

Page 17: Hannah Street (daughter, born 1665) was sealed to "Mr. Griffith" on 21 May 1992 in the Salt Lake Temple. Their marriage date is "about 1686".

Page 21: John Street (father, born about 1598) was sealed to his parents and to his first wife, "Mrs. Street", on 21 May 1992 in the Salt Lake Temple.

Page 21: Jane Street (daughter, born 1633) was baptized 20 October 1988, endowed 5 January 1989, sealed to parents 17 March 1992, and sealed to spouse, Thomas Baxter, 23 October 1992, all in the Salt Lake Temple. Thomas and Jane were married about 1653 of Hawarden, Flintshire, North Wales.

Page 21: Anne Street (daughter, born 1638) was baptized 20 October 1988, endowed 5 January 1989, and sealed to parents 9 March 1989, all in the Salt Lake Temple.

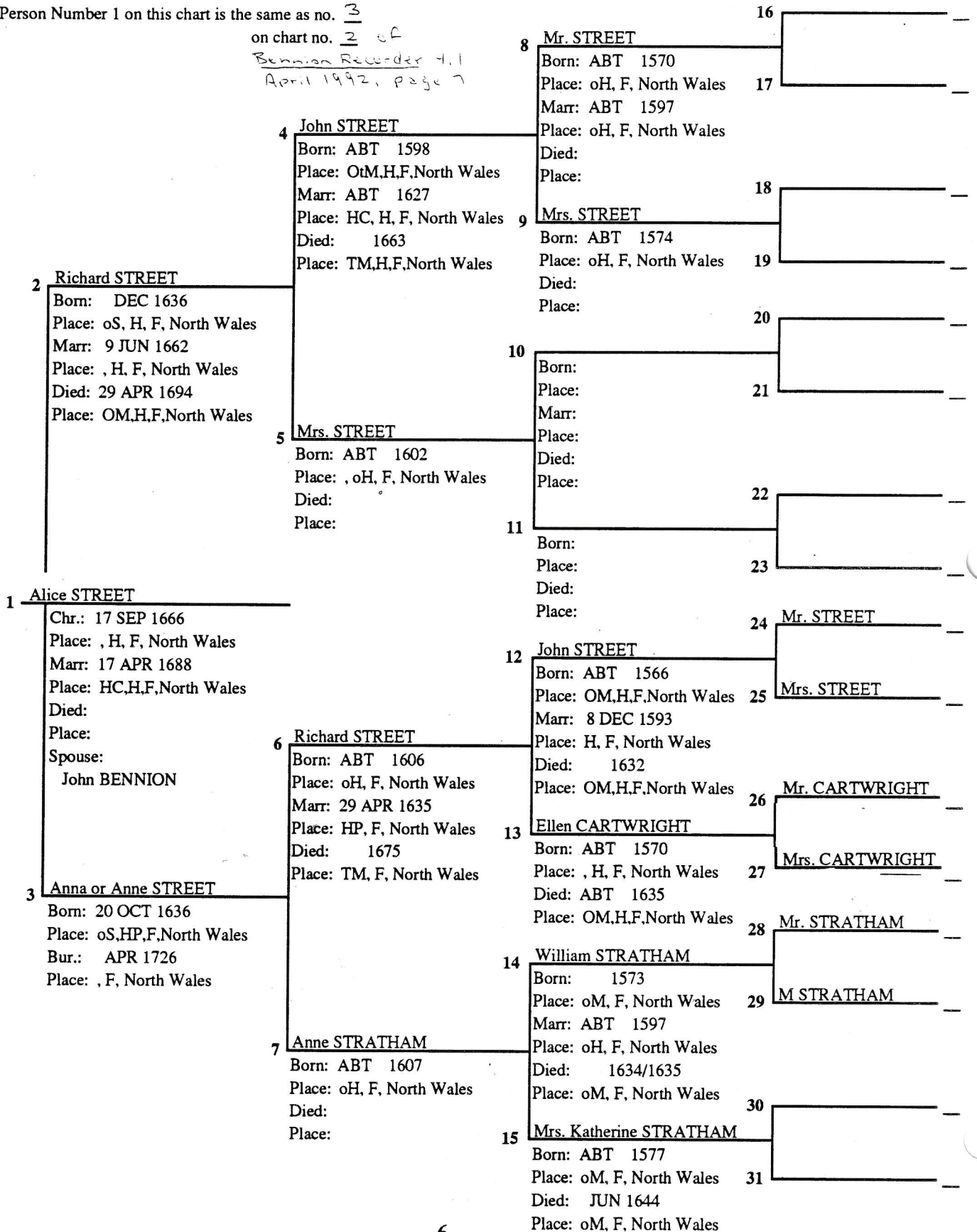
